#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### 1. Enrolment

- 1.1 Availability of classes is subject to change.
- 1.1.1 Attendance Points Enrolment from 9th June 2025 to 28th July 2025 (70% of coaching slots are reserved for Attendance Points registration)

  Enrolment priority is based on Attendance Points (individual's points are available upon request from 2/F Recreation Office New Clubhouse):

  When a class is oversubscribed, the enrolment priority will be allocated based on the swimmers' previous swimming class attendance. Points will be calculated by adding up the total number of lessons a swimmer has attended during HS 2024/25 intake (September 2024 to June 2025) and has maintained a 60% attendance record over the duration of the intake, no points will be issued for special leave. Please refer to the Attendance Points flier for additional information. (Attendance points will not be issued for the summer swimming lessons or programs)
  - In the event of a tie in attendance points, a count-back system will be used as follows:
  - 1) Count the number of lessons a swimmer has attended beyond the previous intakes (up to a maximum of 2 previous intakes).
  - 2) If a 'winner' can still not be found, a ballot will be held.
- 1.1.2 <u>First-Come-First-Served Ranking Number Allocation on 26 July 2025 at 09:00am to 06:00pm online website only.</u>

  (30% of coaching slots are reserved for First-Come-First-Served registration)

Members registering online will be allocated a queue number on a first-come-first-served basis and will be required to submit registration forms by **Sunday, 4 August 2025, 6pm** to confirm their bookings requests. Each Member will be restricted to one Membership account. **No on-site queuing will be permitted**.

- 1.2 The minimum enrolment size for group lessons (Level BI, BII, BIII, IMP & AIMP) is three.
- 1.3 To ensure availability of private lessons for all Members, swimmers may enrol to a maximum of 4 private lessons of 30 minutes per week. Swimmers may enrol for additional lessons if vacant slots are available after the close of enrolment and the subsequent allocation of lessons.
- 1.4 Availability of private lessons is subject to pool capacity. Each coaching lane will accommodate no more than a maximum of 8 persons including both the instructors and students. Members may select instructors from the schedule provided.
- 1.5 Allocations of lessons are made according to the application form. However, The Hong Kong Jockey Club's appointed coach has the final decision of the child's suitability and may make rearrangements according to the applicant's swimming ability.
- 1.6 Coaches will inform students or their parents of any change of level before the enrolment date. Should you wish to contact any of the coaches, please contact the Recreation Office at 2966 1258. The coach will return your call as soon as he or she is available.
- 1.7 Closing date of enrolment for Swimming Program 2025 / 2026:
  - Attendance Points: 28 June 2025, 6:00pm
  - First-come-first-served: <u>4 August 2025</u>, 6:00pm (Timeslots may still be available after the online enrolment. For enquiries, please call 2966 1258.)

#### 2. Withdrawal and Cancellation Policy

- 2.1 No refunds will be made for Swimming Programs that has been confirmed.
- 2.2 No cancellation or refund will be permitted for individual private or group lessons unless an <u>original medical certificate</u> is presented to The Hong Kong Jockey Club within <u>10 days</u> of absence.
- 2.3 In the event of withdrawal from regular courses / programs, advance notice of 7 days prior to end of month is to be submitted in writing.
- 2.4 No make-up classes or the replacing of swimmers with family Members or non-family Members will be permitted.

# 3. Eligibility

3.1 Swimming lessons are only open to eligible Full, Clubhouse & Corporate Members and their immediate familiy who are officially registered with the HKJC Membership Department with the minimum age of 3 years. No guests will be permitted.

### 4. Parental Responsibilities

- 4.1 Children under the age of 6 years attending swimming classes must be accompanied by an adult who is a Member.
- 4.2 Children aged 6 years or above or over 1 meter tall are not permitted to access changing rooms of the opposite gender.
- 4.3 All children must be collected promptly after the lesson / session has finished to ensure their safety at all times.
- 4.4 Children attending swimming programmes must be able to change and shower by themselves.
- 4.5 The Hong Kong Jockey Club will not be responsible for taking children to and from swimming classes or for changing or bathing them.
- 4.6 Children under the age of 12 years are able to access the Changing Room no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of lessons.
- 4.7 Children under the age of 12 years are not permitted to enter the pool before or after classes if not accompanied by an adult who is a Member.

## 5. Others

- 5.1 Members must ensure that domestic helpers / drivers <u>not</u> accompanied by adult Members remain at the Club's designated Domestic Helper Room located at the 2/F New Clubhouse. Domestic helpers / drivers are not permitted to occupy seating or facilities intended for use by Members.
- 5.2 The water temperature of the swimming pool remains at a constant 29°C.
- All programmes will be cancelled upon hoisting of Black Rainstorm Warning and 1 hour prior to earliest expected hoisting peroid of Typhoon Signal 8 as issued by Hong Kong Observatory "Pre-Typhoon Signal Number 8 Special Announcement".
- 5.4 Maximum group sizes may be reduced as required / necessary.
